Motion to pay the presented claims was made by Henderson and seconded by Gully. Voting in favor: Henderson, McMahon, Rabe, Gulley, and Baerwaldt. Motion carried.

Mayor Wiik updated the council on the 2nd Ave Railroad Bridge. The railroad did get the fence on the railing. She is still waiting for a date on a meeting with the city.

Joe Wiik attended the meeting to discuss an upcoming event the Fire Dept. will be holding in February. They will be applying for a temporary liquor license. His concern was if they apply for a certain date and there is inclement weather, will the Fire Dept. be able to use the license for a snow date. He was advised to word it that way on the application. It will be published and a public hearing will be held at the end of the year meeting.

A motion was made by Gulley and seconded by Baerwaldt to hold the end of the year meeting on December 27th at 6:00 pm at the Big Stone Community Center. All in favor, motion carried.

Melissa Sherod, the Municipal Liquor Store Manager attended the meeting to discuss the starting wages for the new employees. After a discussion was held, a motion was made by Henderson and seconded by Baerwaldt to give Melissa the authority to start new employees at the Municipal liquor store at \$11.00 per hour. Voting in favor: Henderson, McMahon, Rabe, Gulley, and Baerwaldt. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Gulley and seconded by Henderson to approve the hiring of Louisa Rolfsmeier at \$9.25 per hour. Voting in favor: Henderson, McMahon, Rabe, Gulley, and Baerwaldt. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Baerwaldt and seconded by Rabe to approve the hiring of Amanda Goergen for part-time in the police department at \$15.00 per hour. She will be assisting the department in catching up on reports. Voting in favor: Henderson, McMahon, Rabe, Gulley, and Baerwaldt. Motion carried.

Officer Goergen brought to the council's attention a discussion he had with the personnel committee on paying him for his un-used vacation. A Big Stone City employee can only roll over 5 days per year. The Mayor asked when new vacation is added to an employee. Sick time and personal time is added at the first of the year and vacation is added on the employee's anniversary. She asked when his anniversary date is and it is in March. The council will re-visit this issue in March.

Being no further business a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Gully and seconded by Henderson. Motion carried.
